Welcome to the *Oldest Sanctioned 50 Mile Endurance Ride in the World!* Due to changes beyond our control, this will be our second year starting and finishing the ride in Cool, CA. You will ride through the rolling hills and of Cool, CA. We expect plenty of natural water out on the trail and wild flowers that always appear during March and April. Following this you will ride down into Old Coffer Dam via Salt Creek Loop and enjoying No Hands Bridge up to Auburn. Auburn allows for some nice challenging hills while you ride above the American River. From there, you will drop back down into the canyon and cross No Hands Bridge for a second time and finish back in Cool.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL RIDERS:

- 1. All camping area must be cleaned of hay, manure and garbage at "Cool Staging Area."
- 2. Protective equine foot wear recommended; if foot wear protection is to be worn, then it <u>MUST</u> be worn at pre-vet, if no footwear protection to be worn, then equine MUST be presented at pre-vet with NO foot protection.
- 3. All horses must be vetted in the night before the ride, no pre-ride vetting in the morning of the ride.
- 4. There will be **no** ties.
- 5. We ask that Generators to be off by 10:00 pm in respect to all other riders and crews.
- 6. All A.E.R.C., California State Park and ride rules will be strictly enforced.
- 7. Cool Staging Area (excluding service rd.), horses <u>MUST</u> be tied to trailer, NO portable pens.
- 8. Service Rd. all rigs MUST be parked off to the side of the road to allow emergency vehicles through and all equines MUST be on the off side of the rd.
- 9. This is a sanctioned AERC event, and all AERC rules and regulations to be followed. Please refer to www.aerc.org for specific details.

CALIFORNIA STATE PARK RULES:

- 1. Auburn State Parks Recreation Area charges a per vehicle/rig fee of \$10.-see entry
 - Please Note: California Poppy Pass does not cover the cost of overnight camping, only day use. Camping/day fees maybe paid prior (included with entry) or collected by ride management at check in.
- 2. No parking outside of designated horse areas.
- 3. No glass containers, no alcoholic beverages allowed in the park.
- 4. Rigs parked along road MUST leave room for emergency vehicles and MUST keep horses on opposite side from road
- 5. No campfires.
- 6. All horses to be tied to trailers if in Cool Staging Area.
- 7. AUBURN No parking/leaving rigs in the south lot ("dirt parking lot" by the trail, with the rails) over night.
- 8. All park rules and regulations must be followed.

SCHEDULE:

CHECK IN: will be from 12:30 pm to 4:30 pm, Friday April 19th, 2024.

Be sure to print and bring your ride packet with you, only vet cards, start cards, meal ticket and camping/parking passes will be available at check in.

PRE-RIDE VET CHECK: 2:30 pm-5:00 pm, Friday April 19th, 2024, veterinarians will examine horses. There will be no "pre-ride vetting" after Questions and Answer session or on Saturday morning.

DINNER: PROMPTLY at 6:00pm Friday, April 19th, hosted by American River Pizza & Grill

All riders will get a meal ticket and additional meals may be purchased at American River Pizza & Grill

RIDE MEETING: 6:30 pm, Friday, April 19th, 2024

9:30am - Ride start

Head veterinarian will announce criteria; ride management will cover trail and logistics.

INTRO RIDE: Saturday only; April 20th

(All Jr. riders 17 and under day of ride MUST have a sponsor and follow young rider rules)

7:30am - Check in 8:00-9:00am - Pre-ride Vet Check 9:00am - Ride meeting

1:30pm - Must be in, followed by final vet exam

STARTING TIME: Saturday, April 20nd, 2024. **50's:** 6:30 am; **MUST** be out by 6:45 am (subject to change)

25's: 7:00 am; MUST be out by 7:15 am (subject to change)

CUT OFF TIMES: Refer to trail map. Times will be **Suggested times** for vet checks, **except for**:

Start Times for both distances 50's Auburn – Hard Cut Off 25's Finish – Hard Cut Off

COMPLETION VET EXAM & B.C. JUDGING:

Completion order will be on riding time not of order of crossing the finish line. (30's see notes below)

50's: MUST meet criteria **WITHIN** 30 mins. of completion time.

MUST have final vet exam WITHIN 60 mins. of completion time.

B.C. **AT** 60 mins. **FROM** completion time.

25's: MUST meet criteria WITHIN 30 mins. of crossing finish line

MUST have final vet exam WITHIN 60 mins. of criteria time.

B.C. **AT** 60 mins. **FROM** criteria time.

NOTE-25's only: Completion time/order is at time of meeting criteria.

COMPLETION & AWARDS: To be given out after final vet check exam.

25's: approximately any time after 11:00 am.

50's: approximately any time after 2:30 pm.

To receive completion; vet card **MUST** be signed by veterinarian and be presented to ride secretary.

Payment Info: Check must accompany application to ensure placement on ride list. There will be a late fee of \$30- for entries received with postmarked date after April 9th, (late fee starts between the dates of April 10th-19th). Any sign ups the day before the ride (April 20th) will incur a late fee of \$30- plus an additional \$10- (\$40- total). No refunds for withdrawals after April 10th, 6:00 p.m. or for No Shows. Riders of equines not passing pre-ride vet check will get entry back minus \$30- administration fee, please allow 30 days post ride for refund. There will be no refund difference if you descend in ride distance. No refunds for cancelling due to weather.

<u>Veterinary and Farrier Services:</u> Should a horse require emergency treatment, or farrier services, payment is the responsibility of the rider and will be handled individually by the attending veterinarian or farrier.

Trail Description:

50 MILER: You will ride two different loops on the beautiful rolling hills of the Olmstead loop including Salt Creek. From there you will then make your way to Auburn along the Western States Trail for a small loop in Auburn and a hold and then ride back to Cool for your finish.

25 MILER: You will ride two different loops on the beautiful rolling hills of the Olmstead loop including Salt Creek and finish in Cool.

NO REFUNDS for cancelling due to weather.

Any refunds will be mailed out by May 27th, 2024.

Bounce check will incur a \$45.00 fee plus entry fee, and miles and points will be with held.

Liability release

Read and sign the following liability agreement: **THIS MUST BE INCLUDED WITH YOUR ENTRY FORM**, 2 pages.

In addition, I hereby release and discharge the American River Classic, the Auburn Area Recreational District and their respective officers, directors, members, employees, agents, contractors, participating landowners and/or affiliated entities (hereinafter "Releases") from all actions, claims or demands that I, my heirs, personal representatives, assigns or spouse, if any, now have, or may have hereafter have, for injuries or property damage resulting from my participation in the American River Classic. I agree that the Release includes injury or damage caused in whole or in part by negligence, active or passive, of the American River Classic, the Auburn Area Recreational District or "Releases."

I also expressly waive any rights I may have under California Civil code 1542 which states, "A General release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing that release, which if known by him must have materially affected his settlement with the debtor."

I acknowledge that equine riding is a sport which carries inherent risks of injury and damage to me. I knowingly assume all risks of participating in equine related-activities and horseback riding and not limited to, mules and ponies, whether known or unknown, including, but not limited to, injuries, death or property damage from: mounting, dismounting, riding, walking, grooming, feeding, use of facilities or trail, falling off a equine, riding without a helmet or otherwise relating to horseback, mule or pony riding or otherwise use and control of, or lack thereof, of the equine.

I have read this release and waiver of liability and indemnity agreement carefully and completely, and fully understands its contents. I am aware that this is a release of liability and a contract between Management and I and I sign it of my own free will. I further agree that no oral representation, statement or inducements apart from the foregoing written agreement have been made, and that I rely on none.

By signing this release I also agree to all of the Auburn State Recreation Area, AERC and American River Classic Rules. Any Violation of these rules can result in disqualification and future participation in American River Classic and result in forfeiting ride entry.

By Signing this Liability Release, you also agree to all rules, including AERC and State Parks, and the terms of what the entry states.
